RS150 Quick Guide

1. Safety Precautions

Warning

- · Do not apply excessive force to the product, throw or give impact to the product using sharp objects.
- · When used by children, a protector or a guardian should give guidance, and check if safety precautions are being followed.
- · Use the device within 0°C to 40°C, and avoid to use in high temperature and high humidity environment. If the product is used in an enclosed environment with high temperature below 0°C or in a sauna, it may cause breakdown, corrosion, heat generation or ignition. Do not put it in an enclosed space. Moisture or liquids can also damage the surface and circuit components.
- · Always use adapters that are certified by ROSE. Other power adapters may cause malfunction or damage the product (degradation in performance).
- Do not spill waste or liquid on the product. This may damage the parts and circuit. If the product gets wet, contact the nearest service center without turning on the power. However, free aftersale repair service is not available in this case.
- · Do not connect antennae or accessories, which are not certified by ROSE, and do not place the product on objects that can cause jamming.(steel desks, microwave, etc.)
- The product is sensitive to radio waves, and its performance can be degraded when used near steel objects or electromagnetic devices.

- · Instruction manual can be modified without notice to users for the improvement of the product's performance.
- \cdot Features and additional services of the product can vary by software and service providers.
- · Data(Pictures, Music, Video Files, etc.) other than the default bell and pictures can be deleted due to carelessness of users or due to product failure and its repair works. ROSE is not liable for damages caused by data loss.
- · If you use Bluetooth with 2.4Ghz wireless LAN together, WiFi connection may be slow or Bluetooth audio may not work properly due to signal interference. If you wnat to use them at the same time, it is recommended to use the wireless LAN connection in 5Ghz band.
- Do not use chemical solutions(alcohols, thinners, solvents, etc.) or detergents to clean the product. Rubbing the product using chemical solutions may generate heat and cause fire. Use a soft cloth or a towel for cleaning.
- Do not dismantle, modify, or repair the product at user's will. Free aftersale services will not be available in such cases. If a malfunction occurs, please contact a designated service center for repair.



4. Connection and Operation

Power Button

- · Turn ROSE on or off.
- · Push power button in 3 seconds, ROSE shows 'Screen off', 'Power off' and 'Reboot'.

LCD OFF

Playing sound on screen off status.

When it is screen off, it will be screen on after push power button.

* It is function which only turn off the screen.

Power OFF

Power is off.



Reboot

ROSE is reboot.

* To cancel, touch any screen other menu.

- · Push power button in 5 seconds, it would be reboot.
- · Power button LED status: Screen on (LED OFF) / Screen off (LED ON)

Bluetooth Remote Controller Pairing

Push remote controller home(🝙) and option button(≡) same time for 3 seconds ▶



BT Remote controller's red LED will light on ➤ Choose setting(🏠) ➤ BT setting ➤

BT switch on(() ► Register new device ► Select 'ROSE RCU' from the list of available devices ►

Pairing is completed when 'ROSE RCU' is selected from registered devices

- * Provided battery usage time is about 4 months but it depends on your usage patterns. Due to battery discharging, it would be happen malfunction so change new battery.
- ** To get to know button function and BT connection, please refer to the detail manual.


Inserting / Removing an External Memory Card

- · An external Micro SD, USB, SSD are supported.
- · MicroSD Card capacity is compatible up to 400GB, USB is up to 512GB and SSD is up to 4TB.

Inserting SSD

- ① Loosen bottom of screws(2ea) ▶ ② Push OPEN indicator, seperate SSD cover ▶
- 3 Put SSD on the SSD cover ▶ 4 Fix SSD by screws in the box ▶
- ⑤ Assemble the cover ▶ ⑥ Push LOCK indicator and tighten screws
- **X** SSD is optional, Only 7mm height is supported.








5. Home Screen and Menu Widget

Home Screen

- · Display icons. Move on to other menus by the left/right scrolling.
- Upper Bar: Displays the Time. Product ID(changeable). Playlist of music currently playing. External input(LOCAL, DIGITAL, LINE INPUT, HDMI(ARC), USB IN, AES/EBU). Displays Alarm. Sleep Timer. Bluetooth. DLNA. Airplay. WiFi or Ethernet Connection
- · Menu Widget: Move on to other menus by the left/right scrolling

This is an external input icon and shows the connection status of LOCAL, DIGITAL, LINE INPUT, HDMI(ARC), USB IN, AES/EBU. You can do this by clicking the Input icon in the In/Out setting menu of the home screen.()



Incoming New Alarm, check the mail box.



Sleep timer setting.



Bluetooth device is connected.



DLNA is connected, it would be restart when click.

· You can use WiFi by connecting the WiFi dongle to the back.

Select Settings() or WiFi icon() ► Move to WiFi Settings screen ► Activate WiFi switch() ► Select searched device ► (Input PW) ► Connected



7. Connecting Mobile Devices

AirPlay Connection

· For Android devices, go to Play Store(Google Play) and install Applications that support AirPlay to begin connection.

- · You can check whether the AirPlay service() is running or not by the color of AirPlay icon at the top end of Home Screen. (Flashing in White: Booting / White: connection available or connected / Blue: Not used)
- · For AirPlay service, RS150 and the device should be connected to the same AP (Wireless Network)

DLNA Connection

- · RS150 and DLNA device should be connected to the same AP (wireless network).
- · When DLNA is activated, You can connect it after appearing RS150 in the App.

Execute DLNA support App ► Select Device ► Connect to ROSE

· When DLNA is connected, the following screen appears and the music is played.



Connecting to Home Network

· RS150 can play files from PC and NAS.

Select music() or video() in homescreen ► Select Folder Button ► Select Network Folder ► Select a device to connect to ► Input ID/PW ► (Check on public, in case the equipment has no PW) ► Confirm

· RS150 and PC or NAS should be connected to the same AP (wireless network). And in your PC, folders should be set as 'shared'.



- \cdot If the information you input is correct, folders and files of the shared device will appear as shown next.
- · Select files to play music and videos.



HDMI

· You can find out the HDMI icon() in the top of right when RS150 is processing Video or ROSE Tube. Showing video clips on TV, Mornitor via HDMI cable after click icon. Select files to play music and videos. click previous icon() or seperate HDMI cable, but Video still play on RS150 display.



ROSE Connect (Remote App)

- $\cdot \ \text{Searching ROSE Connect in App store, Google playstore, It is a variable to download and setup.}$
- RS150 and ROSE Connect must be connected to the same AP (wireless network) and ROSE Connect can remotely control RS150. (Music, Video, Radio, ROSE Tube, ROSE Podcast, TIDAL, Device option setting, and Remote control functions such as Volume / Power.)



MQA (Master Quality Authenticated)



- · MQA is an award-winning British technology that delivers the sound of the original master recording. The master MQA file is fully authenticated and is small enough to stream or download.
- · RS150 includes MQA technology, which enables you to play back MQA audio files and streams, delivering the sound of the original master recording.
- The green or blue dot next to MQA logo indicates that the unit is decoding and playing an MQA stream or file, and denotes provenance to ensure that the sound is identical to that of the source material. It glows blue to indicate it is playing an MQA Studio file, which has either been approved in the studio by the artist/producer or has been verified by the copyright owner.
