

# Klipsch new wireless speaker line counts The One II and The Three II

**Oxfordshire, England, July 2019 – The Klipsch The One II and Klipsch The Three II are coming to the UK.**

Adding to the American maker's Heritage Wireless series, the two new stereo audio systems bring mid-century modern design, complete with superior stereo sound, to the too often 'me too' populated wireless speaker sector.

## **Klipsch The One II**

**£260.00**

Available in black or walnut finishes, the The One II is a small but mighty speaker. Housing a brace of 57mm full range drivers and a 114mm woofer, the 2.1 bi-amplified system sonically punches above its 3.86kg weight, delivering a big sound from its smartly wrapped cabinet. Build quality is excellent with features such as the real-wood veneer and smart, metal switches adding tactile pleasure to visuals.

Measuring just under 33cm across and 14cm deep, the The One II comfortably fits any number of nooks and crannies, including shelves and tabletops. Plug it into the Mains, connect your phone or tablet via Bluetooth 4.0, and you're good to go. The 3.5mm input lets you connect the likes of non-Bluetooth equipped sources, including older portable music players and CD players. The result is a hugely satisfying speaker, delivering simplicity of use together with highly capable sound.

## **Klipsch The Three II**

**£395.00**

Also available in black or walnut finishes, the The Three II is a hugely well-connected model. Input connections count Bluetooth and a 3.5mm input, plus the MM phono stage means you can hook-up

your turntable, while the USB Type B slot accepts a computer of your choice. Klipsch also equips this speaker with 192kHz / 24-bit decoding, meaning that it'll extract the best from high-res audio tracks.

Under the hood, the The Three II employs dual opposed bass radiators, as well as the 2.1 driver array as found in the The One II. The result is an even bigger audio experience, one that fills even larger spaces. Both of the new speakers, of course, benefit from the excellence of Klipsch's acousticians as first set in motion in 1946 by company founder, the late Paul W. Klipsch. The pair also take design inspiration from Paul and his team's early models, channelling a 1950s feel. Blend those classic Klipsch looks with the company's latest audio technology and you have a speaker design unlike any other in this busy segment of the consumer electronics market.
