Superior High-Precision Sound

The Austrian Audio The Composer headphones stand out for their exceptional clarity, intricate detail, and natural sound, creating a captivatingly wide stereo image.

To evaluate the audio fidelity, we turn to the crucial metric of Total Harmonic Distortion (THD). This parameter gauges the extent of unwanted harmonic distortion introduced by a sound-reproduction system as it processes an audio signal.

At the standard measurement frequency of 1 kHz, The Composer boasts an astonishing THD value of <math><0.1\%</math>, showcasing its superb performance. However, what truly sets it apart is its performance at lower frequencies, such as the impactful 60 Hz bass drum thrust. Here, The Composer outshines several competitors, including those from similar or even significantly more expensive price ranges, by delivering THD values up to three times better.

As a result, The Composer achieves an unmatched level of precision and accuracy in bass reproduction, offering audiophiles an unrivaled and delightful listening experience that reveals every nuance of the music's low-end frequencies.

Hi-X Driver Technology

The unparalleled sound quality of the AUSTRIAN AUDIO The Composer headphones is attributed to their exclusive Hi-X (High Excursion) technology.

The headphones boast a 49 mm driver that incorporates a precision CNC machined ring magnet system, featuring N52 magnets known for their exceptional strength. This unique ring design not only enhances airflow but also delivers the most powerful magnetic field in its class.

Moreover, the diaphragm of the HI-X49 DLC driver is coated with diamond-like carbon (DLC), making it exceptionally rigid and shifting the break-up frequencies to higher levels. This critical feature determines the point at which the membrane ceases to behave like a piston and perfectly follows the sound signal. By stiffening the cone without adding weight, these headphones deliver an authentic listening experience across all levels.

Prepare to be captivated by the true and swift impulse bass imaging at remarkably low THD (Total Harmonic Distortion) in the lower frequencies. In combination with a linear frequency response and an open, precise, high-resolution sound signature, The Composer ensures an incredibly revealing listening journey that sets new standards in the realm of high-end audiophiles.



Good Connections

The Composer comes complete with three distinct cables. A Jack plug (TRS) is provided in both 3.5mm and 6.3mm sizes, alongside a 4.4mm Pentaconn connector and 4Pin XLR connectors. The latter two connectors permit a full symmetrical connection, boasting two conductors from the amplifier to the transducer.

Innovatively, The Composer showcases the brand-new Banana Jack connectors, renowned worldwide for their dependable quality and ample conductive surface area. Notably, a deliberate choice was made to employ a nonproprietary plug, allowing for easy accessibility through various retailers. Audiophiles who possess a penchant for crafting their own cables can now embrace boundless possibilities.

The cables attach to the headband rather than the earcups. This ensures any force applied to the cable is harmoniously distributed across the head, sparing the delicate ears from undue strain.

Attention to every detail: The upper section of the cables is enveloped in elastomer, deftly eliminating unwanted body noise interference. Meanwhile, the lower part showcases an elegant woven textile finish, exemplifying sophistication and practicality.

With such remarkable consideration given to every aspect, The Composer offers a flawless union of functionality and style, catering to the most discerning audiophiles seeking an enchanting and immersive audio journey.
